The webinar series will include the following 5 topics:

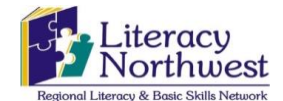
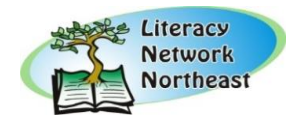
1. Understanding the difference between task-based and skills-based assessment
